Carl Wilkens stayed.

The only American to choose to stay in **Rwanda** after the genocide began in April 1994, Carl Wilkens prevented the massacre of hundreds of children and many adults over the course of the genocide.

Featured in Frontline's *Ghosts of Rwanda* and *The Few Who Stayed: Defying Genocide*, an American Radio Works documentary that aired on NPR, Wilkens' story reminds us of the profound connection between history and the moral choices we face each day.

The continuing **genocide in Darfur Sudan** has prompted Wilkens' multi-city tour in which he asks the questions that challenge audiences to see the human faces of genocide and explores the question:

“What can we do today to stop the genocide in Darfur Sudan?”
